Zav Foundation, Bengaluru based Non-Profit Organization, established/ founded by Aman Jain, President of Zav Foundation, in 2009 when he was in the last year of his Engineering. Aman Jain is also a Head-Learning & Development, & Retail HR at Kantoor Brand India-Lee & Wrangle and pursuing a Ph.D. in Behavioral Sciences from IIM Kashipur. From where all this started? The dearth of quality education in India to students with limited means made Aman start "Mission Zav" with the help of few volunteers. It is when volunteering at a government school in Harohalli (Kanakpura), he realized student's interests and potential, and decided to improve the standards of the educational system (curriculum design and delivery) with teachers for the school children. The Zav Foundation has been working for the last II years and showing tremendous results every year.

It is a platform by **Foundation** Zav Formerly knows as CDSR (Centre for Development studies and Research). It provides various facilities such enabling research scholars, Master students and professors across the country to publish their work on Zav's website under journal named Vikaas. Vikaas is designed keeping Vision 2020 and ( United **Nations** Sustainability Development Goals in the context

Volunteering is described as an activity where someone gives their time to help a not-for-profit organization or an individual who they are not related to. Volunteering is an amazing way to give something back to the world, and in many instances, it can also be an exciting and unique way to see more of the world. You also have the option of spending time among other cultures, learning about how other people from other backgrounds lead their lives. According to science, by measuring hormones and brain activity, researchers have discovered that being helpful to others delivers immense pleasure. Human beings are hard-wired to give to others. The more we give, the happier we feel.

YACSP, a part of Internships and Student Programs, was launched on 9 February 2017 at GHS Hosakerehalli and Ittamadu. YACSP is providing volunteering opportunities to the school's students. Volunteering is by far the best way to get students on the right track for their future. It allows them to gain experience working in the field they want to go into, while also giving back to the community. By YACSP, students develop life skills and become well-rounded individuals. They develop life skills as they get immersed in activities that are outside of their comfort zones. Volunteering helps students become competent and better meet their learning objectives.

Zav Foundation offers various volunteering roles that help the development of the student. These roles range from poster making to the awareness campaign. Some of the ongoing activities are: Paper Bag making from the used paper and newspaper, which is then distributed to the local vendors to spread the awareness of less use of plastic. Note-Book Making is done from the unused or leftover papers and these notebooks are given to underprivileged children, ensuring that these children are not deprived of education. Fundraising is one of the activities where students raise funds and those funds are used to procure raw materials to start a Swayam Self Help Group (Handicrafts, Handmade Jewellery, Cloth Bags, etc).

So far, the YACSP is a program where students get to know more about the society at an earlier age and develop responsibilities towards the society. This program helps to chisel the personality of the student and it helps them to grow up into a responsible person.





# **BUILDS COMMUNITY**

You strengthen your community and your social network when you volunteer. You make connections with the people you are helping and you cultivate friendships with other volunteers.

# **LEARNING NEW SKILLS**

Volunteering allows us to learn more practical skills than we would in a classroom setting. There are so many different charities to choose to volunteer with; each with its own goals and methods of achieving them. The skills that can be gained, go beyond the obvious ones that we might think of at the beginning.

## **CREATE CAREER OPPORTUNITIES**

Volunteering can build valuable professional skills including: time management, people skills and teamwork. The more you feel comfortable with interacting with others within an organization and following a routine that's different from your own, the more employable you become. In addition to this, employers often look for practical experience as a part of their job specification.

## UNDERSTAND YOURSELF BETTER

Volunteering is useful for developing your personality. This experience will help you to understand whether you are a people's person, whether you would like to dedicate your life to helping others and learning other important things about yourself. Also, you will find out what skills you already have and what you would like to develop.

# BUILDS SELF-CONFIDENCE AND SELF-ESTEEM

Doing good for others and the community helps to create a natural sense of accomplishment. And working as a volunteer can also give you a sense of pride and identity, helping to boost your self-confidence further by taking you out of your natural comfort zone and environment.

# OLD PAPER BOOKLET MAKING

Old Paper Booklet Making is the activity where students make books by using the unused paper from the old notebooks. This is then distributed free of cost to those who are not able to bear the expense to purchase, but they want to study and want to make their life bright and sustainable.

To make one or two sides paper booklets from old, left behind papers after the previous academic year. Each student has to make a maximum of 4 books @ 2 Points over 6 weeks and send it to the Centre (details will be given once the activity is completed). Each booklet should have 50 to 60 pages, A4 size.

The idea here is to help them understand sustainability and get them to familiarize themselves with UNSDG (United Nations Sustainable Development Goals).

# PAPER BAG MAKING

Paper bag making is an activity that spreads awareness about no-plastic. The plastic bag is non-biodegradable and also pollutes the environment. To raise awareness and mold the children's mind to say no to plastic, that's why we push the students to make the bag from used paper and newspaper and these bags are distributed to local vendors.

Take up Paper Bag Manufacturing that can be freely distributed to the street vendors later by Zav Foundation. 12 bags will fetch 1 point and students have to earn 32 points over 6 weeks.

The idea here is to help them understand sustainability and get them to familiarize themselves with UNSDG (United Nations Sustainable Development Goals).

# KANNADA LEARNING VIDEO

Kannada Learning Video is a new way to teach underprivileged kids in Govt School by creating videos, as the syllabus is in Kannada medium. The volunteer students help these underprivileged students by using their learning. Each student has to make at least 8 videos to earn 32 Points. For this activity the student should know to read and speak Kannada. The syllabus will be provided to the students and students can pick topics from the same.

#### Requisite for videos:

- The videos should be in MP4 Format with high resolution 720X or more
- Zav Foundation Logo to be at the beginning and end
- Anchor details required- Name, School, Class, Concept Title, Explanation and Zav Contact Details in the end





## **FUNDRAISING**

Fundraisers raise funds, which is used to procure raw materials to start a Swayam Self Help Group (Handicrafts, Handmade Jewellery, Cloth Bags, etc). This fundraising requires students to reach out to family and friends. Even when they are not selling something, it teaches the students that you should always make an effort to stay in touch with people.

They need to raise funds to support the Swayam project, nearly INR 8000 per 32 points. The number of donations can be as many as possible, but information about the organization and its initiatives have to be shared by the student with potential donors. Students will first need to understand about Zav Foundation and his/her role while doing fundraising activities. We do not wish to encourage students to get money from parents, as giving us that amount technically would mean a certificate for money, which is not our intent. The idea is for a student to take initiative in support of a Non-Profit Org and creating awareness for development related work. Receipts for every donation, be it small or big will be sent to donor email-id, donations above INR 2000 will require a Donor's PAN.

## SWAYAM PRODUCT FUNDRAISING

Various products have been manufactured by the women and underprivileged individuals, which is marketed by the name of Swayam. Swayam refers to a sanskrit word which means Self-Reliance. The beautiful jewellery, cloth bags, potlis and designs crafted by the women at the Center are marketed under the brand name Swayam by Zav, providing the necessary operating income for running the Center and the women who are a part of Swayam.

Interested participants will have to talk about Swayam and the kind of work that happens in Swayam, basis which they will have to encourage their potential supporters to purchase the items from our inventory. INR 1500 worth sales will correspond to 8 points, multiples of INR 1500 will be applicable. A maximum INR 100 difference from the nearest multiple will be considered but nothing more than that.

# **VOLUNTEER SCREENING PROCESS**

# **Step 1- Fill the Application**

• Fill all the details in the Google Form. All fields are mandatory.

Note: Your Name should be as per your 10th mark sheet/ Aadhar card.

# Step 2- Scrutiny

• After completing the form, the Zav Foundation team will review your application.

# **Step 3- Offer Letter**

• After your application is found satisfactory, the offer letter will be sent.

# **Step 4- Orientation**

• Upon acceptance, you will be invited to a mandatory orientation. This covers the Zav Foundation's policies and procedures, expectations and guidelines for volunteers.

# **FLOW OF THE ASSIGNMENT**

- Choose your assignment.
- Read the details regarding the assignment that you have chosen from the prospectus.
- Start working on the assignment
- Submit your **Reflection Journal**: Reflections are essential and also an easy way to internalize your learning journey. Here, you have to write in detail about what you have done, what you have learned out of it, your experience, etc. **Timelines**: If you have started your program on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday; You have to submit your Reflection Journal on Sunday of the same week. And if you have started on Thursday, Friday, Saturday; You have to submit your Reflection Journal on next week Sunday.
- After completion of 6 weeks, students have to submit their assignment to the Zav Foundation's Centre for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship.
- Your assignment will be evaluated by the respective team of the Zav Foundation.
- After evaluation and finding the assignment satisfactory, your points will be updated and the e-certificate will be dispatched to the respective student.

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

QI- Do I have to pay any fees for volunteering? Ans- No fees need to be paid for volunteering

Q2- How long does it take to complete this program?

Ans- It takes 6 weeks to complete this program

Q3- What are reflections? Why is this required for participating in YACSP?

Ans - Just activity is of no consequence, what you learn from the activity is critical and Zav intends to facilitate that learning journey, reflections are an easy way to internalize the same. Guiding questions and method of documenting/creating a video has been provided in the reflections section

Q4- What if I forget to submit the Reflection journal?

Ans- If you forget to submit a reflection journal for 2 consecutive weeks, the candidature for the existing batch will not be considered. This reflection shows your seriousness towards community service and your learning takeaways.

Q5- What if the donor forgets to put the name in the influencer(volunteer student) name? Ans- This is not a problem at all... The influencer name helps us to map the donations initiated by the respective student. In case, the donor forgets to fill the influencer name; after the donation is made, the donor takes a screenshot of the successful payment page and the student can save it for reference. (Please refer to the fundraising guidelines). We will later cross-check the details and do the needful.

Q6- Do donors donate by cash?

Ans- We do not accept any cash donations.

Q7- Can I Volunteer from home?

Ans- Yes absolutely, this program is purely home-based volunteering and we do not encourage students to leave home unnecessarily in this pandemic situation.

Q8- How old do I have to be to a Volunteer?

Ans- Your age should be less than 16 years.

Q9- When will I get the e-certificate?

Ans- After the evaluation of your assignment. It usually takes 8 to 10 days post completion of all your assignment submissions.


