

BLOOD DONATION CAMP

In these difficult times as we are trying to go back to normalcy, the supply of blood in blood banks is crucial. Regular collection and camps in various regions of the state were halted as a result of the frequent lockdowns, leaving thalessemia patients in a difficult situation as they must undergo regular blood transfusions.

To overcome these difficulties Zav, held two blood donations camps, first one on April 11, 2021 and the second one on March 6, 2022 at Gayatri Hospital, Vijayanagar, in collaboration with Rashtrothana Blood Bank. For blood collection, the Covid19 standards and precautions were carefully followed. Donor passes were made available to donors upon request to support the project's successful operation. Lunch was provided for the medical staff, as well as refreshments for blood donors.







EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVES

Giving away books allows them to live again. For many children from disadvantaged backgrounds, books—both new and gently used—mean the world to them and may even be the only books they ever get to call their own. Books teach children empathy and the distinction between good and evil, instill morals and ideals to them without seeming preachy, helping them make sense of the world around them.

With this in mind, Zav, donated around two hundred books, two desktops and printers to Karnataka Seafarers Charitable Trust. These are to be used by the government schools in Vidyanpura locality, Bangalore.

Mr. Ramachandran, who received the books on behalf of the trust expressed his gratitude by saying "Today, we collected around two hundres books and two desktop systems and Printers from Mr Satish, ZAV Foundation. These will be used in the Government Schools around Vidyaranyapura, Bangalore. We heartily thank ZAV Foundation for the donation."





DONATION OF TAILORING MACHINES

As a way of extending support to our students who have taken up our courses at centre for skill development and entrepreneurship, we at Zav decided to support our students with tailoring machines, hence based of appropriate criteria, few students for our school and L&T Vocational Training Centre, Arahalli, were identified and up to five tailoring machines in all were donated to the students.

The program was a resounding success, and many of the participants are able to find employment post training. The initiative was a life-changing experience for many of the students, and it helped them create a brighter future for themselves.
